Treasurer's Report

We will have State of Washington papers soon to include with our IRS paperwork. Judy has finished tax reports for 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, and 2019, with the help of CPA Hilary Dansing. Brenda Lance made important phone calls to Washington Secretary of State regarding past filings in our name. Historical Washington State records identify us as Music Teachers of Clark County. Therefore Elizabeth Morris is re-typing our by-laws to conform with the Washington state records hoping to avoid any IRS confusion. After IRS approves our non-profit status, we will probably amend the by-laws to read CCMTA going forward. Cinda Redman will complete the IRS form regarding scholarships. The final submission of forms to IRS should take place by March 16th. IRS filing bill is \$600. Treasurer's bank report filed.
